Radiology Ordering Quick Tips

Ordering Physicians <u>please</u> provide all or as much of the following when ordering Imaging Studies

Information "MUST HAVE"	DESCRIPTION
1. CONTEXT / SIGNS SYMPTOMS	Provide ALL SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS patient is experiencing relevant to this imaging exam; include any relevant prior procedures and previous treatments, underlying conditions, history of, what is the intent of imaging study imaging ordered for what condition?
2. REASON FOR EXAM	Provide as much detail as possible around the reason for exam.
3. LOCATION OF IMAGING	Provide the specific anatomical sites requiring imaging such as left right, upper, outer, etc., include as much information on laterality, quadrant of organ, location of the bone, individual vessel occluded
4. SEVERITY	Indicate on the order whether it is Acute or Chronic, Traumatic or Non- Traumatic, Open or Closed, With or Without Hemorrhage, With or without perforation
5. STORY	Provide information to let radiology know what was the patient doing, where did event happen, what was patient's status at the time.
